## TRANSWORLD SEED GRANT

### 1. Introduction

The Transworld Group of Companies, a multi-faceted shipping and logistics conglomerate, needs a technical resource partner and is accepting proposals in response to this RFP. Because transformational social change requires breaking down the barriers to development and building a strong foundation of knowledge, skills and networks at the grassroots, Transworld Group conducts its CSR work across four issue areas, which act as pillars in the organization's strategic framework.

The four areas are:

- 1) Education, Arts & Civic Engagement;**
- 2) Gender Equity & Inclusion**
- 3) Stewardship of Marine Environment**
- 4) Health, Food & Water Security**

Each of our four issue areas of environmental and social responsibility reinforces and builds on the company's core values, which are **Customer Centrality, Transparency, Integrity, Respect and Excellence**; these core values embolden the company's CSR commitment to funding long-term programs and strategic initiatives which will hone and leverage internal expertise, help NGOs secure external funding and establish partnerships for effective programmatic implementation and impact evaluation. The grant will initially be for a period of one year, extendable based on success of the pilot. The Transworld group will be open to funding grantees and project partners that working on innovations in the pillars mentioned above.

### 2. Geography

**Preference will be given to projects taking place in coastal areas and communities in and around Maharashtra and Gujarat.**

### 3. Scope of Proposal

#### *STEWARDSHIP OF MARINE ENVIRONMENT*

Port, harbors and maritime development can have serious ramifications for many aspects of the environment. Studies have correlated port and harbor development with the following problems

1. **Water related impacts:** impacts caused by dredging, construction of piers, breakwaters and other structures, ship discharges (oily ballast, bilge water and sewage) and spills (detection and cleanup of spills).
2. **Land related impacts:** waterfront drainage, increased traffic burden, displacement and involuntary resettlement, trash and litter entering watershed and aquatic ecosystem, and industrial set-up and run-off into wetlands.
3. **Air related impacts:** GHG emissions from ships and hazardous material in cargoes.
4. **Ocean bio-diversity and livelihoods impact:** Projects reducing negative impacts on marine bio-diversity and enhancing livelihoods of indigenous communities.

Transworld Group commits to sustainable ocean shipping. We are seeking NGO/trust/government supported institutes partners to advance sustainability initiatives and increase ocean accountability across the ocean shipping industry. Given the scale of this project, we are reaching out to various organizations who can help us with regard to the following:

1. **Research for designing an innovative mechanism or technology to curb impacts caused by port and harbor development with focus on impacts created by the shipping industry.**
2. **Project developing sustainable community-based solution in port villages.**
3. **Projects aimed to conserve marine biodiversity.**

#### *Selection Guidelines*

Transworld will consider the following guidelines when evaluating potential grantee and project partners.

1. **Innovation and creativity**
  - potential to address an important problem or a critical barrier to progress in the field
  - potential to improve or apply a new theoretical concept, approach, methodology or tool
  - degree to which the research is original, unique and creative
  - potential gain relative to (any) perceived risk
  - degree to which the research proposes new paradigms or challenges existing ones.
2. **A Holistic Approach** to proposed project or intervention with a goal for long-term system change.
3. **Community involvement and investment** in the organization achieving their mission.

4. **Focus on sustainability** to ensure the long-term success of sustainable initiatives and projects with proven benefit.
5. **Dynamic leadership and strong governance** of the organization with the ability to inspire others with their vision.

#### **4. Submission Guidelines & Requirements**

*Your problem-solving process can be at any stage, including: identifying the need, building shared understanding of the issue, generating ideas or testing and implementing solutions. Proposals can focus on one area or span multiple stages.*

##### *Eligibility*

1. Not for profit organizations, universities, think tanks, government supported research institutions and social enterprises with prior experience on such projects will be given preference.
2. Organization with at least three years' experience and a turnover 1-3 crores will be given preference
3. Management Structure with established systems and processes that ensure responsible management of accounting and reporting.
4. Applicants must adhere to comprehensive non-discriminatory practices in hiring and providing services and must demonstrate a commitment to diversity and inclusion within their organization.
5. Should not have any legal matter/dispute pending in any court of India

##### ***The following submission guidelines & requirements apply to this Request for Proposal:***

1. Proposal responses should appropriately address the attached project framework. Any application that does not answer a section within the project framework will be considered incomplete.
2. When appropriate, responses should detail the roles of both the grantee and the Transworld in implementing and running a successful program.
3. The proposal should not be based on outdated research methods and possess an innovative edge.
4. As part of their selection process, Transworld will conduct a limited number of interaction with select beneficiaries of the organization advancing to the final round of consideration.
5. If you have a standard set of terms and conditions, please submit them with your proposal. All terms and conditions will be subject to negotiation.
  - a. Proposals must be received prior to June 4th to be considered.

***The total timeline for evaluation and selection of agency will be done within a maximum period of two months.***

*Terms and Conditions for Funding*

1. Funding will be in a phased manner and grantees will be paid 50% of the grant on agreement, 30% on a successful mid-term review and 20 % on submission of a project completion report.
2. The Transworld group does not support cash payments for direct budgetary support. All payments will be made through cheque/NEFT.
3. Funds should be used for field activities and attainment of deliverables.
4. Funds should not be used to organize seminars, meetings, events outside the scope of the project.
5. The final report should include a financial report on expenditures made as part of the project.
6. Within the one-year life cycle of the grant, grantees will be expected to submit a 6 month and annual report on the outcome and impacts.

## PROJECT FRAMEWORK

### 2. Statement of Purpose

**The statement of purpose** should describe the problem that the project will attempt to address, the targeted beneficiaries and how it fit into your vision and mission and aligns with broader development goals such as the SDGs.

### 3. Program Description

**Describe the project or program and provide information on how it will be implemented. Include information on what will be accomplished and the desired outcome.** Expected outcome and expected impact through empirical evidence.

### 4. Goals & Objectives

In this section, you are asked to list and describe a maximum of five (5) of the project's main objectives. Please provide a concise description of each main objective (between 150 to 200 words).

### 5. Activities

List and describe the main activities that you will need to carry out in order to produce the outputs/deliverables, specifying the implementation schedule (start and end date), the location and target beneficiaries.

### 6. Outputs

Clearly state and describe a maximum of four outputs/deliverable with key performance indicators and means of verification, which will serve to measure the successful implementation of the project.

### 7. Impact

The proposal should be designed along a comprehensive theory of change specific to the organization. In this section state the long-term goals and impact the program is expected to achieve and how it connects to your strategy.
